Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission into the 2008/2009 academic session programmes leading to the award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE), Postgraduate Diploma in Theology as well as Master's and Doctorate degrees of the Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- (a) The programmes are either on full-time or part-time. Most programmes require a year and a half of course work followed by a project for the Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) and a Thesis for Master's degree, and the Doctor of Philosophy degree.
- (b) The Master's degree programmes last three semesters plus 3 months of project work. The Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree takes a minimum of 3 years (6 semesters) for full-time and 6 years (12 semesters for part-time students). The Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) (Part-time) programmes of the Institute of Education are run during long vacation. The PGD non-formal Education (PGDNFE) and the Professional Master's degree in Labour Education (MLE) of the Institute as well as those of the Institute of Part-time programmes, based in the Faculty of Social and Management Sciences are run on weekends.

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

### **(a) The following shall be eligible for admission into the degree of Master of Laws:**

- (i) a holder of a Bachelor of Laws degree of the Adekunle Ajasin University, with a minimum of Second Class Lower Division;
- (ii) a graduate of any other university recognized by the Senate with a minimum of Second Class Lower Division.
- (iii) a holder of a Bachelor of Laws degree with third class and Postgraduate diploma in Law may be considered for admission into the LLM degree.

### **(b) The following shall be eligible for admission into Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) Laws:**

- (i) a holder of a Master of Laws degree of the Adekunle Ajasin University;
- (ii) a holder of a Master of Laws degree of a University recognized by Senate.
- (iii) a holder of a Master of Philosophy (M.Phil) with a minimum aggregate grade of 60% or B, or a Cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 on a 5-point scale at the M.Phil level.

## **E INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION**

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

### **(a) Postgraduate Diploma in Theology – Part-Time (2 years)**

Candidates must each possess any one of the following qualifications:

- (a) A first degree from a recognised University or a recognised College of Theology/Seminary, or an HND from a recognised Polytechnic.
- (b) In addition to (a) above, each candidate must obtain a recommendation from the recognised Head of his Church.

### **(b) Master's Degrees.**

- (i) A first degree passed at the First or Second Class Honours Division of the Adekunle Ajasin University or of any other University recognized by Senate.
- (ii) Candidates with equivalent degrees from other Universities recognised by the Adekunle Ajasin University.
- (iii) For the professional degree of Master's in International Studies, the requirement is a first degree in any of the following: History, Philosophy, English, B.Sc. in Economics or Political Science or Public

Administration; or LL.B The degree must be passed at the Second Class Lower Division at the very least.

**C Doctorate Degrees**

Applicants for admission into Ph.D. degree programmes must each have attained a minimum aggregate grade of 60% (B) or a GPA of at least 3.5 on a 5 point scale or at least 2.8 on a 4 – point scale at the Master’s, or equivalent level obtained from this University or from any other University or educational institution recognised by Senate..
